11. A girl studying piano and singing at the Conservatoire, who has to practise regularly in the afternoons.
12. An Afro-American with his Austrian girlfriend. He is trying to get a work permit as an engineer.
13. A religious Muslim family which lives strictly according to the Koran, the mother leaving the house only veiled.
14. A gay man who is single, but invites a lot of men during the week in his apartment.
15. A young man, who uses a wheelchair and lives with his seventy-six-year-old mother.
16. A girl, who is blind. She lives alone with her dog.
